












## Volleyball Girls U19:



## Sh. Nasser bin Hamad Football Championship (Secondary School)

Every academic year, the school kicks off its football season with what is considered the strongest football tournament in Bahrain, the Sheikh Nasser bin Hamad Tournament, organised by the Ministry of Education. Both public and private schools participate in this tournament, adding to its challenging and exciting atmosphere.

Our football team participated in this year's tournament with ambition and a desire to achieve the highest goal possible. Students, teachers, departments and officials worked together to create a competitive team that plays modern and competitive football.

#### The team played two matches this year.

The first was against Beacon School: The team put in an outstanding performance and showed tactical discipline, which contributed greatly to their control of the game from the first minute until the final whistle. The team managed to score three goals after some excellent tactical moves.

The second was against the British School: This was the qualifying match for the group stage. The team entered the match with anxiety, tension and a desire to win, with mixed feelings due to the strength of the opponent and the news circulating about them. The team entered the match with determination, focus and strength, and with the referee's whistle and the passing of the first few minutes, the players' confidence and discipline began to show, and it became clear that they could win today.


